

## Penthouse Prinsengracht

Location: Amsterdam

Tom Postma Design created a high-end interior for a unique penthouse at the Prinsengracht, known to be one of the most beautiful canals in Amsterdam.

### Floor plan

Through optimisation of the original penthouse floor plan of this converted former maternity ward, we transformed and enhanced the volume of space to create a unique spatial environment. Our interior design provides for a contemporary, sophisticated home that accommodates all our client's requests and wishes.

The exclusively designed 175 square-metres penthouse with terrace comprises two individual seating areas, a brushed all-brass kitchen, a bedroom with en-suite bathroom, as well as a hidden guest room with walk in closet and private bathroom.

The independent seating areas are connected by a marble corridor and view lines throughout the penthouse reveal and embrace natural daylight.

### Interior design concept

The interior design concept is inspired by the richness of materials presented in still life paintings by the Dutch old masters. We created a contemporary environment where contrasting combinations of materials are carefully balanced with contrasting textures.

Rich materials like silk, marble, brass and oak are being combined to create striking compositions of colour and texture. Innovative material applications throughout the interior express our bespoke design concept and show the versatility of the different materials.

The stunning collection of handmade curtains and rugs are exclusively designed for our client by Dutch textile designer Samira Boon.

### Seating area

The seating area overlooking the Amsterdam canals, showcases a handmade wall-covering cabinet executed in American walnut.

This 'James Bond' like feature is accommodated with a hidden bar, humidor, wine cabinet and screen and can be operated through domotica. The invisible home automation system and whips are fully integrated in marble and the silk walls.

## Lounge area

The lounge area on the north-side of the apartment features an oak-wood panelled wall that folds out to reveal a hidden guest room. This hidden feature converts this lounge area into a luxury guest room with walk-in closet and private bathroom.
