

# Façade

We are convinced that the façade's composition is crucial to achieving a coherent character for this sculptural, pentagonal building. As the link between the existing historic city center and the newly built CiBoGa area, we wanted our building to be rhythmic and sympathetic, radiating positive energy, to help residents feel at home and connected to the neighborhood.

The base of the façade is made of bricks laid in a woven pattern. Above, between the dark-gray horizontal bands, the subtly inset windows and thermal wooden panels rhythmically repeat in shifting, staggered beats. The rhythms, contours and textures of the façade create a light, sympathetic and vivacious building.
